



### Professor David Bowtell

Professor Bowtell holds a Joint appointment as a Group Leader and Senior Principal Research Fellow at the Garvan Institute for Medical Research and is also Head of the Cancer Genomics and Genetics Program at the Peter MacCallum Cancer Centre.

Professor Bowtell has an extensive background human cancer genomics. He is Principal Investigator for the Australian Ovarian Cancer Study (AOCS), one of the largest population-based cohort studies of ovarian cancer in the world involving over 3000 women, and CASCADE, a rapid autopsy study. His work is part of the International Cancer Genome Consortium, an ambitious program to map the genomes of the 50 most common cancer types. Professor Bowtell's research has focused on the classification of ovarian cancer, and mechanisms of primary and acquired drug resistance.
